Dear Friends of Heart Care Ministries,

I have often shared that people are damaged in one of two ways. One is by receiving something that they weren't designed to receive or didn't deserve. This usually comes through abusive mistreatment or feeling pressure to some extent. It usually is not to difficult to determine when a person has been hurt in this way due to the obvious circumstances they have experienced. The other way a person can be damaged is by not receiving something that God designed for them to receive. I have a belief that every person was designed by God to give and receive love. It is surprising the number of people that express they have never felt love before. They may perhaps have never doubted that they were loved but have never felt an emotional connection. That is simply when love is not just assumed but is felt. There is a promise in scripture that is often overlooked or underestimated that I have selected for the theme of this newsletter. It is expressed in only three words. "LOVE NEVER FAILS." There are a number of ways in which people seek to define how the love mentioned in 1 Cor. 13. is to be practical. I would suggest the idea of this kind of love is described not as an impulse but rather an intention to love regardless if anyone loves back making it unconditional. One of the simplest descriptions of God is found in 1 Jn. 4:16 "GOD IS LOVE" He has demonstrated His love to us through Jesus. One primary point we offer here is that God desires for every human heart to experience love. To know that they are significant and were created with purpose. There was a young man who shared he never felt loved by anyone. His father left when he was young leaving him to feel he was unlovable. His dad was very sarcastic and would laugh at him as he tried to work. His mother did the best she could but caused him to feel drained by expressing how hard she had it and constantly crying. Due to her own abandonment pain unknowingly she caused him to pull away and he became rebellious. People would reach out to help but he would derail relationships every time they would start to develop. He shared he didn't trust anyone to love him because every time he had either been hurt or felt controlled. When he felt someone caring for him and was led in prayer to resolve his many issues he began to understand that God loved him. His heart began to feel like reaching out to other's. He had never focused on other people before without a selfish motive. He said, "I have never felt so clean and free to love. Isn't love amazing?" I said, "Yes love is amazing!" God knows that love satisfies the need in every human heart. Love motivated God and He gave us Jesus ...to set us free. Jn 3:16 When we choose to love we engage one of the most powerful forces on earth. Yes love is amazing...because love never fails!

HEART CORE ISSUES

This section is used to identify issues that affect a person's heart.

Pressure Pattern are when a certain behavior is demonstrated that causes another person to react negatively because of pain.

Pressure Patterns



Dominance/Control

To exercise control over; to govern; to rule over; to dictate; to be assertive; to be bossy; to have one's own way

The Characteristics of a Dominant /Controlling Person

Like to be in charge; Take control of decisions; Exerts pressure to have other's do it their way; Desires to dominate another

The Consequences (Reaction) to Dominance/Control

A person can't stand being controlled; Will block others when they seek to control; Will rebel against being told what to do; Will say "No one is ever going to control me again; Will disassociate/emotionally detach whenever someone tries to control them.

The Character of Dominance/Control

In Ex. 1:13-14 is an example of the Egyptians exercising control over the children of Israel. The account says they made their lives "bitter with hard bondage...they made them serve with rigor."

While God saw their hardship and raised up a prophet to deliver them called Moses we see a reaction throughout the history of Israel of harden hearts and rebellion. Twice in Acts (3:22; 7:37 reference is made of Moses sharing that God would raise up a Prophet like himself and they should listen to Him. God has raised up Jesus to deliver from bondage and to set free from the dominant control of sin. He continues to speak to us today and promises to deliver all who trust in the power of His word.
