Dear Friends of Heart Care Ministries,

October marked the second year of this ministry for which we give thanks. It has been amazing how God uses something as simple as faith and prayer mixed with a small handful of purpose to accomplish His will. When we moved to Montana we had a desire of someday providing a place for people who had become weary in their walk with God. Initially we pursued the dream, but due to a number of constraints and even a few unaccounted for setbacks, we kept adjusting and praying for God’s direction. Through a sequence of events along with a few doors miraculously opening for us, we took a step of faith and Heart Care Ministries was born. While the ministry is not what we had initially envisioned, we are grateful for the opportunity God has provided for us. In retrospect we look back over the last couple of years and are amazed how the Lord has strengthened us through times of weakness and supplied for us in times of drought. The story of the little boy tossing starfish that had washed ashore back into the ocean describes the goal of this ministry in making a difference in people’s lives. Someone asked him how he thought he would ever make a difference since there were so many? The little boy responded by picking up a starfish and tossing it back into the water saying “sure made a difference for that one”. We spend time with people hoping to make a difference in their lives, one heart at a time. Counseling is a broad term and has been construed to include a variety of different ideas. We actually don’t consider ourselves to be a counselor but rather a mentor or care coach. Our primary focus is to help people identify issues that has caused them to struggle and to assist them in resolving those issues. In the remaining section of this article I would like to share a brief overview of our process. First of all effective counseling requires cooperation. It is important for a person to be honest about their issues and willing to take steps toward resolving them. It is my firm belief that only Jesus has the solution to anyone’s problems. There are 6 specific areas we like to cover when someone schedules an appointment at HCM. **1. Diffuse the Insecurities:** It is important to build a bridge of trust and try to break down any concerns or apprehension a client may have. **2. Determine the Information:** This is where we listen to a person’s life story and try to understand a person’s life experience. **3. Define the Issues:** This is where we put the pieces of a person’s past experience together to try and figure out how it has affected them. **4. Disconnect the Irritations or Injuries (Pain)** Here we lead a person in prayer seeking to connect to Jesus who is able to care and bring peace into their pain. **5. Develop the Intimacy:** Training a couple how to emotionally connect to experience oneness in their relationship and each individual to accept their oneness with Christ **6. Discover the Independence:** Helping them experience freedom to be the person God has created them to be.

HEART CORE ISSUES

This section is used to identify issues that affect a person's heart.

Over the next several months I would like to use this section to discuss and explore the damaging aspects of Pressure Patterns. A Pressure Pattern is when a certain behavior is demonstrated that causes another person to react negatively because of pain.

7 Pressure Patterns that can cause a person to be damaged

- 1) **Expectations (Pressure to Perform)** To achieve, to expect, to accomplish an action, to carry out, to count on
- 2) **Dominance/Control:** To govern, to rule over, to dictate, to have ones way, assertive
- 3) **Expressive:** controls verbally, to talk
- 4) **Not Talked To:** To be quiet, Doesn't communicate
- 5) **Focus on Self:** Selfish, Thinking only about me, Everything is about me
- 6) **Anger:** To be angry
- 7) **Critical/Judgmental:** adverse comments, to disapprove, to disparage, to condemn, to make cutting biting comments
